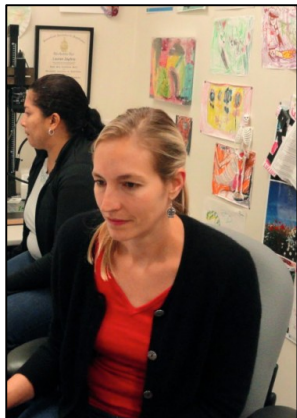

### ERIK ZABORSKY - ARCHAEOLOGIST

Erik Zaborsky is the Archeologist for the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Central Coast Field Office in Marina. He is also the Archeologist for the Fort Ord National Monument and California Coastal National Monument. He has been the Archeologist at the local BLM office since 1998. He received his BA in Anthropology at UC Santa Cruz (Crown 1994), then earned a Certificate in Archaeological Technology at Cabrillo College, and finally received his MA in Anthropology at California State University, Bakersfield.
